- You must attend a training session. No exceptions. 50 volunteer hours are required before September 30th, 2020 to successfully complete the program. This does not include training nor required ZooTeen Luncheon.
- Volunteer Fee: \$25 to cover the cost of T-shirt and Training Materials. If this causes any financial burden please contact Peoria Zoo Education at 681-3559. (Volunteer Fee is due at the end of the 2nd day of the Zoo Teen training session.)
